#### F&P/37/2020 BANK AT BURNFOOT

Verbal report by the Clerk. Julia met with Cumbria Rivers Authority who said that the erosion of the bank was due to a branch from a Sycamore Tree that is on the bank of the beck. If the branch was removed this would help and the bank could be built back up. This should help stop any more erosion. If it is classed as a main river then permission would need to be sought from the EA. There was also another sycamore tree that could be removed.

It was **AGREED** to ask Stephen if he could remove the branch, if not a quote would need to be sought. There was no agreement from the committee to build the bank back up.
