 - a) Mrs Smallwood re: memorial garden letter

 EL People walk over other graves in the cemetery. GG grass path along hedge might be a solution, or move bench (family bench). Family will meet William/George to see what arrangement can be made. If moving the bench and planting a shrub will solve the problem, the arrangement will have to be confirmed by the family. During this time Mrs Smallwood will be kept informed of progress. She seemed happy to go along with this proposal.
 - b) Mr Morten re: his son's grave. The pegs will be removed and a shrub of his choice planted before Christmas to mark the corner. More levelling will be done in the spring if necessary. Mr Morten was satisfied with this proposal.

Other issues arising from the public (emails):

- 1. The Dolan headstone this matter will be dealt with by EL who says there has been confusion between family members.
- 2. Complaints from two members of the public re: removal of flowers and ornaments. M Clark said she and a friend of Wigton Cemetery cleared all the dead flowers weekly plus any broken ornaments. Glass was proving a problem, so any glass found is removed (see rules). The Committee will look into the use of plastic in the New Year many cemeteries are introducing new rules.

After Christmas we will need some winter maintenance – bush trimming and edging paths. We need to look for three quotes.

Christmas wreaths – removal can start end of January – we will follow the same procedure as with flowers – remove the withered ones first.
